I can't believe we are in Term 4 already! At the end of last term, the children went on an excursion to "the Abby Museum" extending on their knowledge of Ancient Egypt. They enjoyed an activity of mummifying a classmate and being archaeologists with a wonderful Egyptian dig, where they discovered all sorts of artifacts.



This term, we have started working on our class play, "The Odyssey" as part of our Ancient Greek Main Lesson. The students have been learning lines, creating costumes, and making props. We have also been reading a retelling of the Odyssey as a class reader.

We will finish the term with a

free hand geometry Main Lesson and then a revision unit called "What did we do in 2022?". The class have been busy with music, verses and art, as well as focussed activities and quizzes to develop automaticity with our maths facts. It is wonderful to see the improvements in just a week!



# Yuka - Japanese



Class 1 and Class 2/3 have been learning about Japanese sports and the Sports day in Japan held in October. They learned about sports carnivals in Japanese schools and Japanese national sport which is Sumou — they enjoyed making a miniature Sumou game!

Class 4/5 has been practising more conversational Japanese language. Some students who are usually quiet in lessons are very keen to participate presenting it in front of class. It was so nice to see their motivation and enthusiasm!



Class 6/7 and 8/9 have been studying about Haiku which is a Japanese short poem. They expressed about spring in their Haiku and wrote it in Hiragana.

This week, they are going to present (speaking out) their own Haiku in front of class.
